TWO AMATEUR RADIO STATIONS TO CLOSE

Will be Merged in 3BA BALLARAT, Saturday. —

The 3AL, Amateur Radio Station, which has been operated by Mr A. D. Kerr, is to be closed down permanently after tomorrow. It will be merged into the new "B" class station about to be established in the Commonwealth Bank Chambers. 3WA, operated by Mr W. A. Wilson, is also to be merged into the new station, the wave length of which will be 230.8 metres. Its call sign will be 3BA. Messrs Kerr and Wilson are helping in the establishment of the new station.
